

MOOSE LODGE 1308 MONTHLY RENOVATION & EXPANSION UPDATE

Welcome to the first of what will be monthly updates on the progress we are making toward our expanded, renovated, and remodeled Lodge. Our Lodge committees, along with our Board of Officers, have had multiple meetings with our professional construction team, local banks, as well as Moose International. And, *as you already know, our fundraising campaign is now in full swing.* When we reach our campaign goal and complete the construction process we will all enjoy a more spacious, comfortable, efficient, and aesthetically pleasing Moose Lodge facility that we can be proud of for years to come.

The plan is that our total project will be performed in specific stages so we can, as much as possible, minimize disruptions to our Lodge operations and Membership enjoyment, while also ensuring that our professional construction management team can perform its tasks as efficiently and cost-effectively as possible.

Construction Phase #1: At the April 15th Board of Officers meeting, it was decided that Phase #1 of our construction project will be focused on the renovation and extension of the Lanai area. Beginning in this area will allow us to have much needed additional table seating while the next phases of construction proceed. Our Lodge's fire sprinkler system is also scheduled to be installed during this first phase.
