President's Message

Greetings fellow Venice Moose Members. I hope all is well with everyone. This article will be a bit lengthy as there is much to cover. First, recapping some events from February. Those that watched the Super Bowl at the lodge had a great time, especially the winners, and I don't mean the Eagles. Close to 80 of our members enjoyed some fun on the Moose Cruise to the ABC islands and another 86 members enjoyed the Manatee 58 picnic at Port Charlotte. There is always something going on at the lodge, and if you get involved you are sure to have fun.

Upcoming events at the lodge for March: on the 2nd we will be starting Country Music on Sunday afternoons at the lodge so come on down and dance the day away. Also, that night there will be a comedy night at the lodge with several comedians who have donated their time to entertain us at no cost, so we could donate all the proceeds to charity. So far over \$4,000 has been sent to Moose Charities from this with more to come. A Big Thank You to Venice Moose Member Rocky Mangiarano, for putting this all together. Sorry but the show sold out within a couple of days. Next up is St. Patrick's Day and we will be serving our famous Corned Beef Dinner form Noon to 4pm. Tickets are \$20 and available at Member Services. Only a limited number of tickets are being sold so get your tickets early.

Looking ahead to April, mark your calendar. On the 13th, we will be having the Bob Anderson Memorial golf outing. Get your team together and sign up. If you can't make the outing, become a sponsor for this great event with the proceeds going to Special Olympics. On the 27th there will be an Elvis Tribute dinner show, starring Vito Ameruoso (Tat2) at the lodge. Posters are displayed with the information.

Now for some business. We met with Moose International representatives earlier in February to discuss our plans for the lodge. We explained that there are projects that we have to do: a new roof and a complete fire suppression system. We need to make more room for our members, as our membership is increasing. We HAVE to have additional seating. They went over our financial records and asked a lot of questions, which were answered. Then they told us that at this time we could not afford to take out the 2.6 million dollar loan that would cover the entire project that we wanted to do which would include a new kitchen and all the other renovations we wanted to do, because we would be paying at least \$15,000 a month on the loan.

Then the Good News. They said that with the money we had raised already, we could go ahead with the new roof, the fire suppression system and the renovation of the lanai.

The process now involves getting three separate bids for each of those projects and submitting the best bid for approval, which they will approve. Our contractor is now securing those bids for us and we will send them along as soon as possible. FINALLY, the process has started. The Moose International team also told us that if the membership made more donations and we continued to get our costs down, we would have no problem getting approval for the remainder of our renovations.

It is the time of the year for Lodge elections. If you would like to become an officer in the lodge, the elected positions of President, Vice President, Chaplain, Treasurer and Trustee are open for nominations. Nomination forms, requirements and instructions are available on the bulletin board in the hallway by the bathrooms.

Sadly it has been brought to my attention that some members are making rude and disrespectful remarks to other lodge member in the social quarters. It does not matter if you are a full time or part time resident, the fact is that we are all Moose Members and should be treated as such. NO EXCEPTIONS!! If someone comes into the lodge, it does not matter if he is a full time resident, part time resident or a member from another lodge visiting our lodge. He is to be treated in a friendly, courteous manner, the same as you would expect to be treated at any other lodge. Please don't be the person who makes our lodge look bad.




