Membership Retention

Vital to our existence is the retaining of MOOSE members and offering support to Mooseheart and Moosehaven. Without your continued membership in our fraternity we would not be able to assist charitable organizations in the Venice area.

Every member who is reading this should look at the lower righthand corner of his/her membership card. The date that appears there is when your dues are up for renewal. As a suggestion, I would pay a few weeks before that date of expiration so that your membership privileges would continue uninterrupted. Some members are of the belief that there is a "30 day grace period". That is definitely NOT TRUE. Sec 30.4 Nonpayment of Dues reads as follows: Every member will be in arrears after the expiration date of their dues. A member in arrears shall not be entitled to any privileges of membership nor be considered a qualified guest. It is the member's responsibility to know the date their dues will become delinquent. A member's failure to receive notice of their dues or arrearages shall not release them from responsibility to pay their dues on or before the due's expiration date. A member in arrears shall be dropped from the rolls after the expiration of twelve (12) months." That is the procedure we MUST follow in accordance with Moose International.

My retention committee must now make phone calls to 192 members who didn't renew during the month of February. Thanks for reading and I hope you will not be one we have to call in the future.
